The Wilsons unique sound is created by the voices of Steve Wilson, Rich McCarthy, and Anne Martinson. Their rich, sweet harmonies and the anointing of the Holy Spirit combine beautifully in the creation of "Music that blesses the soul." Their excitement and charisma are sure to be a blessing to those attending their concerts.

Chart climbing singles, "I'm A Know It All" and "Helping Heart," written by Ronny Hinson, gave the Wilsons a new direction. Their single, "When Morning Comes" spent numerous weeks on the charts, many of which were spent in the #12 position and another single, "Mama, Don't Forget to Pray for Me" climbed to the #2 position and remained there for several weeks. Nominations for multiple awards have been very rewarding and encouraging to this young artist.

Steve Wilson and The Wilsons have recently completed a new project, which was produced by Ronny Hinson. This project includes songs written by Rebecca Peck, Ronny Hinson, Bruce Haynes, and Buddy Mullins.
